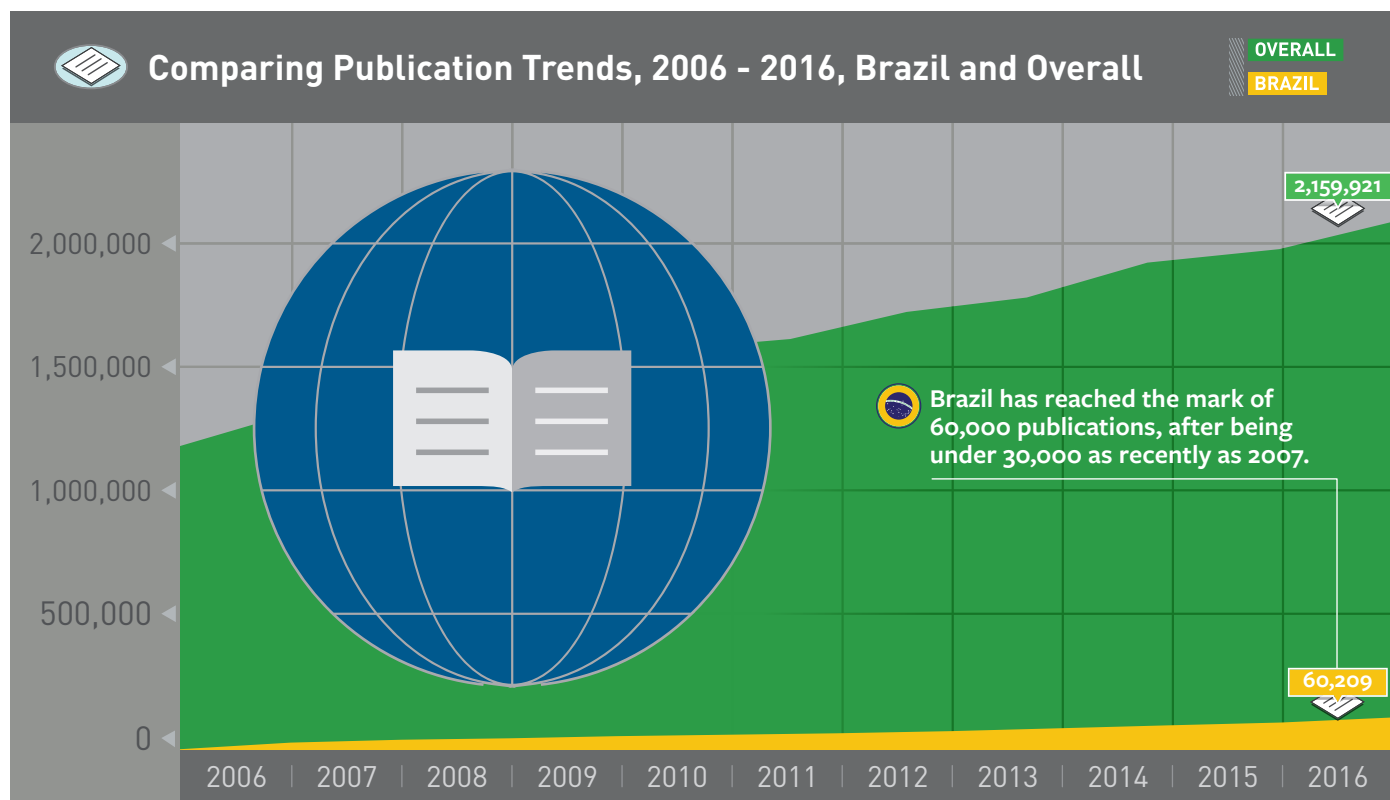


AJE Scholarly Publishing Report: Brazil

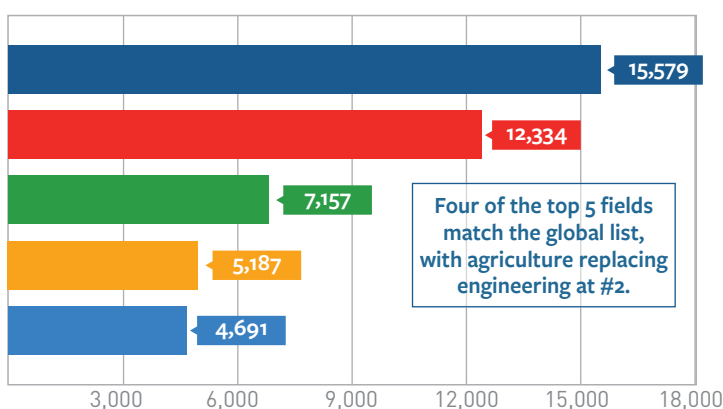
In 2016, Brazil saw about a 10% in publication output, compared to 7% worldwide.

by number of publications

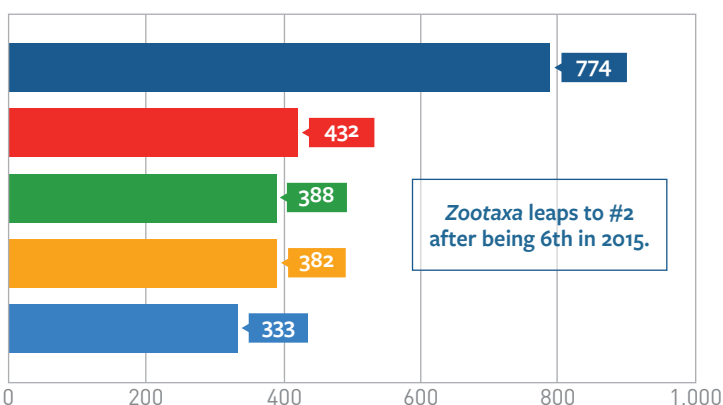

by number of Brazilian publications

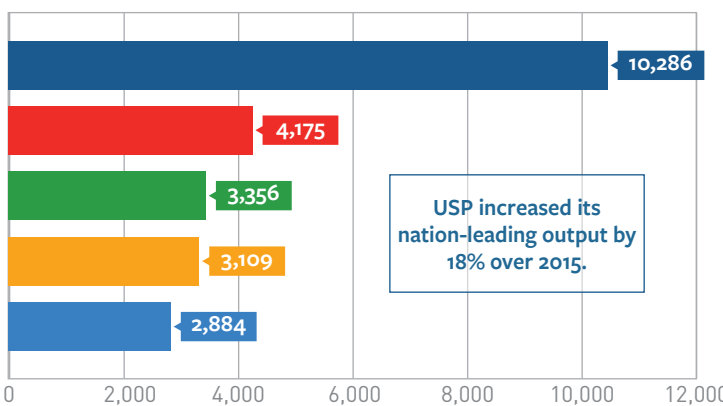

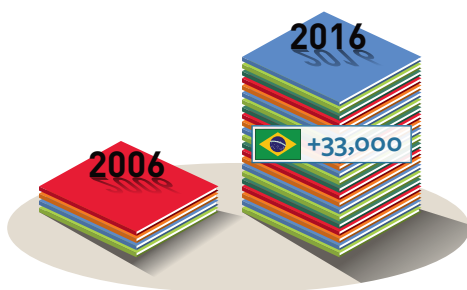

Brazil's now produces approximately 3% of all papers published, more than at any point in the last 10 years.
